

Solar Regional Mitigation Strategy for the Afton Solar Energy Zone in New Mexico; Public Workshop in Las Cruces, NM, May 3, 2016.

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) is developing a Solar Regional Mitigation Strategy (SRMS) for the Afton Solar Energy Zone in New Mexico. The BLM will host an all-day public workshop on May 3rd (beginning at 8AM) at:

The BLM is developing this strategy to identify potential impacts of solar development in the SEZ and appropriate mitigation measures to address these impacts, in particular through regional compensatory mitigation. There will be additional opportunities to attend meetings and otherwise provide input as the SRMS is developed.
