

The Bureau of Land Management uses modeled data to predict the lifespan, pressures, and volumes of helium in the Federal Helium System. The modeling suggests that the helium supply will extend beyond the program's September 30, 2021 legislative end date. The current FY 2014 maximum production capacity is 1.45 bcf (billion cubic feet) with 90% of this value as the engineering targeted production. The projected maximum helium production capacity for FY 2015 is 1.32 Bcf.
