

## Notice of Public Meeting

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Farmington Field Office (FFO) is seeking additional comments on the developed alternatives for the Glade Run Recreation Area (GRRA) proposed recreation management plan. There will be a 20-work day comment period that will begin March 3, 2010 and continue through to March 31, 2010. All comments must be submitted either in writing and mailed to the FFO, 1235 La Plata Highway, Farmington, NM 87401 or sent by email from the BLM website at [www.blm.gov.nm](http://www.blm.gov.nm) with the heading *Glade Run Recreation Area Proposal*. All comments must be postmarked or date stamped no later than midnight of March 31, 2010 to be considered. All comments will be made public unless indicated. Alternatives will be made available for reviewing at the FFO public room, online at the BLM FFO website [www.blm.gov.nm](http://www.blm.gov.nm), and by request from the FFO outdoor recreation planner beginning March 3, 2010.

A public meeting will be held on March 16, 2010 at San Juan College (4601 College Blvd, Farmington, NM), Henderson Fine Arts building room 9008 from 6 PM to 8:30 PM to review the alternatives from the GRRA proposed recreation area management plan.
