1. Please provide your name, address, daytime telephone number, and up to three weekend dates you would like to be considered for (weekends for this purpose are launches that take place on Friday or Saturday, June 10-11, for example) between early May and Labor Day weekend.
2. Complete your return address on the reverse of this card, and put a stamp in the upper right corner (check usps.com for current rates).
3. Fold this card on the perforation and enclose it in an envelope along with your check for \$6.00 made payable to USDI-BLM. All entries must be postmarked on or before January 31, and sent to:
