Dear Interested Party,

The Bureau of Land Management has prepared an Environmental Assessment (EA) to analyze the potential impacts associated with the issuance of a Special Recreation Permit (SRP) to conduct an endurance running and obstacle course event in the southern portion of the Battle Mountain District. The Proposed Action would be to issue a SRP to Tough Mudder, LLC, to conduct the event October 6-7, 2012, north of Beatty, NV, in Nye County. The event will be held primarily on private land with 4.7 miles of running course to occur on public land.

Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and Council on Environmental Quality regulations that implement NEPA, the EA identifies, describes and evaluates the direct, indirect, and cumulative resource impacts associated with the proposed activity.


This EA will be available for public comment and review starting immediately. Copies of the EA may be obtained by notifying the Tonopah Field Office at the above address or from the internet address below:
