***Silver Saddle Ranch***  
**“Do You Need a Permit?”**

A Special Recreation Permit (SRP) or a Visitor Use Registration (VUR) may be required if you would like to reserve the facilities or conduct a special event, meeting or activity at **SRS**.

**A VUR (Form - SSR VUR) may be required for:**

- Scheduled use of the Red House, Root Cellar, Corrals, Riding Arena, or Fields
  - Fewer than 100 individuals attending a wedding, picnic, 4-H activities, etc.
  - Fewer than 25 people using the Red House and Lawn areas.
  - Proposed use is before or after day-use gate closure hours (7:00 a.m. – 5 p.m.)

**An SRP (Form 2930-1) may be required if you answer “Yes” to the following:**

- The activity is Commercial, Competitive or an Organized Group Event
- A fee is collected to earn a profit, cover event expenses, or raise funds for charity
- You advertise or invite the public
- A course will be marked
- Cash Awards will be given to participants

**BLM may collect Use Fees when an SRP or VUR are required**

**BLM Special Recreation Permit (SRP) Fee Schedule:**

- According to the National and Field Office Special Recreation permit policies
- As of 2008: \$95 minimum annual fee, or \$5 per participant per day, or 3% of Gross Receipts, whichever is the greater amount
  - Exclusive Commercial Use: \$190 (March 2008 – March 2012)

**Silver Saddle Ranch Visitor Use Registration (SSR VUR) Fee Schedule:**

According to the Silver Saddle Ranch Business Plan as of 2004 the reservation fees are:

1. Group Area / South Riding / Root Cellar areas (100 or fewer visitors):  
\$55 Half-day; \$100 Full-day
2. Red House including lawn area (maximum of 25 people at one time):  
\$50 Half-Day; \$75 Full-Day
3. *Pole Barn is not available for public occupation due to wind damage (2007)*
4. Riding Arenas: fees to be determined through the SRP Process

**Timeframes and proposal review:**

- New or unusual proposals that may require an SRP must be received by the BLM a minimum of 180 days prior to the scheduled event date.
- Picnics, weddings, meeting, etcetera may be accommodated on a shortened time frame, but are subject to first-come-first served status.
- All proposals will be evaluated on a case by case basis to ensure compatibility with management goals, public safety and resource protection.
