
This is [REDACTED] and this is in regard to the conversation we had today regarding the stud horse.

Yesterday (Sunday), I was on my horse, leading a mule in between Deer Run Road and the river. The mule stopped & I looked back to see what was happening. The mustang was starting to mount the mule. This horse is so gentle you cannot hardly drive it away from you. It is a nuisance, and if some of the young people were to encounter this horse, and now aware of how to respond, there could be a possibility of someone, or their animal getting harmed.

This horse has been around here for a couple months, and is getting bigger & stronger. He is very gentle, and most of the neighbors are worried about him. However, as I said, he's getting bigger, and causing a bit more disruption with our animals.

If there's anyway to capture this horse, it would be appreciated. It would be grand if someone would like to have him for their own. He's so friendly! He'd probably make someone a good horse.
