Dear Reader:

The Tuscarora Field Office has prepared an environmental assessment (EA) for construction of fish barriers on Maggie and Susie Creeks. The barriers would prevent non-native fish species from gaining access to habitat for Lahontan cutthroat trout. Maggie and Susie Creeks are tributaries to the Humboldt River and are located west of Elko, Nevada.
