The Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Wells Field Office, has completed the Northeast Nevada Wild Horse Eco-Sanctuary Resource Management Plan Amendment and Environmental Impact Statement Scoping Summary Report (Scoping Report). The Scoping Report summarizes all of the issues raised and comments received during the initial public scoping period for the proposed Northeast Nevada Wild Horse Eco-Sanctuary.
