The BLM Tuscarora Field Office has completed a Draft Standards and Guidelines for Rangeland Health Assessment for the Wilson Mountain Allotment. This assessment displays all available monitoring data on the allotment and draws draft determinations on the level of attainment of the Standards and Guidelines for Rangeland Health. The assessments will be available for review on June 29, 2012 at the Elko District's website at: on.doi.gov/elkoGrazing. Hard copies of the document are also available from the Elko District Office upon request.

The BLM is seeking input from the permittee, affected agencies, and members of the public interested in livestock grazing management on the Wilson Mountain Allotment. Input will help with developing management strategies and alternatives that are in conformance with the Elko Resource Management Plan.
