Dear Interested Party:

Barrick Gold U.S. Inc., Bald Mountain Mine (BMM) is proposing to expand their existing gold mining operations as well as to modify previously authorized facilities. The project area is located 36 miles NE of Eureka at Big Bald Mountain. The BLM has previously authorized BMM to disturb 8,262.0 acres within the North Operations Area Plan boundary and 11.1 acres within the Little Bald Mountain Plan boundary. The increase in disturbance would include pits, rock disposal areas, heap leaching, roads, growth media stockpiles, and interpit areas. This proposed amendment will increase ground disturbance from 8,273.1 to 8,899.2 acres in White Pine County, Nevada (see attached map).
