Dear Interested Party:

Tetuan Resources Corporation has submitted an Application for Permit to Drill (APD) for a wildcat oil and gas well in northern Railroad Valley, approximately 19 miles south of Highway 50, in White Pine County, just northwest of Green Springs, Nevada. Access would be from Highway 50 on an existing county gravel road. Access to the drill pad would be from White Pine County Road #5, on approximately one mile of newly constructed road across a desert scrub community. Total project disturbance would be approximately 6.25 acres. Approximately 250,000 gallons of water would be consumed during drilling operations. Water would be obtained by drilling a water well on the drill pad location. Gravel for construction purposes would be obtained from a nearby gravel source yet to be determined. Drilling operations should commence by summer of 2013.


