

DECISION DOCUMENT
Round 5 Lincoln County Archaeological Initiative
Lincoln County Land Act

The Bureau of Land Management Nevada State Director hereby approves the estimated expenditures from the Lincoln County Land Act (LCLA) Special Account and other authorizations outlined below, with the provisos as stated.

The total expenditure authorized from the LCLA Special Account for Round 5 is \$1,022,825 for the following Archaeological Initiative projects and Special Account Reserve:



Authorization for expenditures for projects submitted in Round 5 as set forth in this Decision Document shall not be construed as final approval for any particular expenditure. The amounts authorized herein are not approved for expenditure unless and until all requisite procedures are followed as outlined in this document and in the *LCLA/Lincoln County Conservation Recreation and Development Act (LCCRDA) Implementation Agreement*.

The establishment of reserve within the Special Account in the amount of \$100,000 is authorized for expenditure during Round 5 at the discretion of the Executive Committee toward allowable expenditures under the LCLA and in accordance with the *LCLA/LCCRDA Implementation*

Agreement, where special circumstances warrant. All expenditures from the Special Account Reserve (SAR) shall be undertaken in compliance with established procedures and internal controls as well as all applicable laws, regulations and policies. The SAR authorized by this decision shall be available during Round 5 only. Funds not obligated or allocated during Round 5 will be returned to the Special Account for allocation to the recommended budget in the next round.
