

Eagle-Caliente Complex Emergency Wild Horse Gather Fact Sheet

What: Eagle-Caliente Complex Emergency Wild Horse Gather

Where: The Eagle Herd Management Area (HMA) is approximately 30 miles north of Caliente, Nevada. The Caliente Complex Herd Area (HA) is approximately 10 miles south of Caliente, Nevada.

Planned number of horses to be captured: 100 excess wild horses

Planned number of horses to be removed: 100 excess wild horses

Population to be left in HMA/HA: Approximately 2,066 wild horses

Planned duration of gather: Up to six days

Reason/s for the Gather: The wild horses are a safety concern on U.S. Highway 93 and Nevada State Route 322.
