

WHAT TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

Instructions for visitors to the Pancake Complex Wild Horse Gather

Where to meet: Visitors to the gather will meet at the White Pine County Park across from the Best Western Park Vue Motel, 930 Aultman Street, in downtown Ely, Nevada. Meeting time generally occurs at 6:00 a.m., Pacific Standard Time (PST). Please call the Pancake Complex Wild Horse Gather Information Line at 775-289-1880 the evening before you want to visit, as the gather time will change.

Transportation: All visitors are required to have their own transportation. Vehicles must be 4-wheel drive, preferably high-clearance. Please make sure that the gas tank is topped off before meeting at the White Pine County Park. Also check to ensure that the vehicle's tires, including spares, are properly inflated. Drive time from the park to the gather site is up to 1 ½ to 2 hours.

Attire: Attire should be muted in color to blend with the surrounding environment. Brown or beige colored clothing is suggested. Please do NOT wear bright colors, or black or white, as those colors draw the attention of the horses being gathered. The BLM also suggests dressing in layers.

Lodging: Lodging is available in Ely, Nevada.

Amenities: Ely is a full-service community.

Weather conditions: Temperatures can be expected to reach the low to mid-30s at the gather site(s). In Ely, highs can also be expected to reach to the low to mid-30s. Expect low temperatures to drop to as low as zero degrees (Fahrenheit).

What to bring:

- Layered, muted colored clothes (see Attire)
- Sturdy, closed-toed shoes
- Coat, Hat and Gloves
- Sunscreen
- Food and water
- Toilet paper*
- First aid kit
- Binoculars
- Camera with zoom lens
