

## ADDITIONAL STIPULATIONS FOR FILM PERMITS

1. A copy of the video will be submitted to the Authorized Officer of the BLM.
2. A provision for credit to the BLM will read as follows for use of public lands.

3. All vehicles will be limited to a maximum speed limit of 35 mph on any roadway or trail located on Public Lands.
4. Permittee shall indicate by name a person of authority, along with a current address and phone number, who will coordinate the on-site activity with the BLM.
5. Permittee will ensure that no surface disturbance will occur as a result of any activity authorized by a permit.
6. Permittee shall not damage, collect, or introduce plants or animals at any location authorized by a permit.
7. Should a desert tortoise enter the area of filming or photography the permittee will immediately stop all activity until such time as the animal has left the area of its own accord. In addition, the permittee, participants, and spectators are not authorized to take, harm or harass any desert tortoise found on Public Lands. The authorized officer shall be notified immediately of any tortoise occurrence. In addition, all permitted employees and support personnel must sign the Desert Tortoise Acknowledgement of Compliance form provided as part of the permit. This form will be returned to the BLM within fifteen (15) days of the permitted activity along with the post-use report and any additional user fees.
8. Still photography permits that do not cause any surface disturbance or use motorized vehicles and that meet the criteria above would be authorized anywhere throughout the Resource Area unless other restrictions take precedent. Use limits for these areas would be restricted to no more than five (5) vehicles and fifteen (15) people for any filming or photography session.
9. The painting of rocks or the establishment of permanent markers or improvements is prohibited.
10. Permittee shall immediately stop all activity should archaeological resources be discovered while involved with commercial filming and still photography. When these resources are discovered, the authorized officer shall be notified immediately.
11. Permittee shall place signs and other warning devices as deemed necessary by the authorized officer to warn the public of the action taking place.
12. Permittee shall ensure that all litter, garbage, props, or other evidence of the authorized activity is removed within two hours after completion of the activity. All litter and garbage will be removed to a county approved landfill. The authorized officer will be provided with proof of receipts of disposal upon request.
13. There would be no more than five (5) vehicles allowed in any operation at the Bitter Spring and Gold Butte Back Country Byways, the Black Mountain Communication Site road, Big Dune, and Christmas Tree Pass, however, up to ten (10) vehicles may be allowed in any operation located on the Gold Coast 300 and Nissan 400 OHV courses, Nellis Dunes, Jean, and Roach.
14. There will be no more than fifteen (15) people allowed in any operation at Bitter Spring and Gold Butte Back Country Byways, the Black Mountain Communication Site road, Big Dune, and Christmas Tree Pass, however, up to 40 people will be allowed in any operation at the remainder of the sites stated under 3 above (as depicted on Map 1).

15. All vehicles and support equipment shall be limited to existing approved roads accessing film and photography sites. Motorized cross country travel is not authorized under any circumstance.
16. No vehicular travel is authorized on El Dorado Dry Lake and/or Jean/Roach Dry Lakes in the event of rain. No vehicular traffic is authorized on the dry lake beds while the lake bed is wet or until all puddling has dried.
17. Permittee shall be responsible for the supervision of all participants, spectators, and other persons associated with the activity, and will be responsible for public safety on-site.
18. Permittee must contact and receive concurrence and license, where required from all state, county, and local governmental agencies having jurisdiction, concern or interest in this activity.
19. Permittee shall be responsible for ensuring adequate sanitation facilities for participants is provided.
20. This permit does not give permission to cross over or use any private land. The permittee will be fully responsible for all trespass on and/or damages to private land which result from the permittee's activity.
21. Permittee will do everything reasonable, both independently and/or upon request of the Authorized Officer to prevent and suppress fires caused by their activity on or near lands utilized. Compensation may be required of the permittee for Federal, State, or private interests in suppression and rehabilitation expenses.
22. When livestock, wild horses, burros, or any wildlife are in the area of filming or photography, care should be taken not to harass or frighten the animals.
23. Permittee will not remove or damage mining claim or land survey markers. In addition, permittee will not interfere with authorized mining activities.
24. The permittee is not authorized to camp on public lands.
25. The permittee shall review the brochure describing cultural and paleontological resources prior to each filming and photography session of the following: "It is illegal to collect or disturb archaeological materials on Public Land without a permit issued from the BLM. These permits are only granted to qualified archaeologists associated with institutions or contracting firms. Violators will be subject to criminal penalties."
26. The exclusive use of BLM administered Public Lands is not granted.
27. The use of pyrotechnics, helicopters, and aircraft is prohibited. Catering is prohibited throughout the Resource Area.
28. Disclosure of all aspects of the proposed activity must be completely described in the application. Any changes to the proposed activity must be approved in advanced by the authorized officer.
