Through an interagency agreement with the Bureau of Land Management, the Volpe National Transportation Systems Center/U.S. Department of Transportation (Volpe Center) will be conducting a Comprehensive Transportation Feasibility Study (Study) for Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area (RRCNCA). The Study will assess alternatives for improving access to and travel through the RRCNCA. At the Open House on July 21, 2011, the Volpe Center team will present the project objectives, key activities, and schedule. During the Open House, members of the public can provide feedback on the Study objectives and planned tasks.

The Study will build upon previous efforts over the past decade to identify and address congestion, parking, and other transportation issues at the RRCNCA. The Study will consider a range of multi-modal alternatives, including transit and non-motorized alternatives, as a means to improve access and mobility on the Scenic Drive and throughout the RRCNCA. The Study is scheduled to be completed in the spring of 2012.
