6 CAMERON CLARK: My name is Cameron Clark. I
7 live across the street from Liberty High School here in
8 Henderson, Nevada, and my feeling on this proposed mine
9 project, I don't know everything there is yet to know
10 about it, but I am very opposed to it.

11 Having looked at the signs out front in the
12 open house that were showing what proposed benefits
13 there might be to the community, I feel that they're
14 minimal in comparison to what is going to be a major
15 disadvantage to homeowners in this area.

16 When I purchased my home in 2007, I had no
17 idea that a proposed mine site could be developed
18 further down the road and would be within hearing
19 distance and probably, you know, breathing distance of
20 it. The proposed number of workers are between 15 to
21 20, so the argument can't be made that a lot of new
22 jobs will be created. The wages will only be \$18 an
23 hour. That's not a good argument for why it should be
24 there.

25 As far as I could tell, I don't see any

1 advantage to the residents in the surrounding area. My
2 home is now valued at 45 percent of what I purchased it
3 for back in 2007, so in four years I've lost 55 percent
4 of the value of my home. Not likely that I'm going to

5 see a lot more if this mine is to be developed.

6 I would think that the BLM has a lot of other
7 areas where minerals, such as the minerals they're
8 proposing to be taken from the earth, so to speak, are
9 readily available, and I think that they should be
10 exploring places that are further from populated
11 locations beyond where the area is.

12 when I purchased my property, it was with the
13 idea that Inspirada would one day be developed, the
14 master planned community across from St. Rose, which
15 would boost property values, but now it looks as though
16 that's not the case. Especially if a mine comes in, I
17 don't see any developer who would in their right mind
18 want to continue to develop that master planned
19 community.

20 so once again, I'm totally opposed to this
21 project. That's it.
