\* The funds associated with the Secondary List would come from reallocation of any funds that become available from approved primary projects, as well as previously approved projects, if those funds are not needed to complete primary list or previously approved projects. Secondary List project funding will be determined through the review and approval process identified in the SNPLMA Implementation Agreement. Secondary List projects make up reductions in scaled primary projects or would provide additional funding to high priority program areas; that is, these amounts are distinct from the amounts requested in the Round 12 primary project list. For example, if both the primary and secondary Camp Richardson Resort BMP Retrofit projects were to be fully funded the total amount eventually expended could be \$5.5 million.
