

**SNPLMA Partners Working Group  
Summary of Decisions and Actions  
September 2 – 3, 2015**

The Partners Working Group (PWG) held the subject meeting to primarily focus on addressing (1) a Round 14 Special Account Reserve (SAR) request for a new urgent Conservation Initiative project from the Bureau of Land Management's (BLM) Ely District, (2) a request from U. S. Forest Service (FS) for a time extension for the Mahogany Grove Campground (FS32) Capital Improvement project, and (3) a suggestion to develop an alternative recommendation for the WP07 and WP08 Park, Trail, and Natural Area projects at Camp Success.

**Decisions Made:**

- By a split vote of three in favor and three against, the PWG agreed to forward a motion to recommend the EC approve the BLM's Basin and Range National Monument SAR request to:
  - Recommend \$408,000 in Round 14 SAR funds to the Secretary for an urgent project to conduct planning and environmental assessments, project equipment, travel, official vehicle use, and cost of contracts and/or agreement to perform project;
  - Change the time period of the request from two to three years; and,
  - To clarify that the SAR funding can only be used for activities within Lincoln County.
  
- The PWG unanimously approved a motion to recommend the EC approve a one-year time extension for FS32 with a requirement that the FS provide the Southern Nevada Public Land Management Act (SNPLMA) Division quarterly reports documenting actions and progress being made to resolve the Request for Equitable Adjustment. In addition, the SNPLMA Division will provide the PWG with quarterly reports of the actions and progress made. At the end of the one-year period, no additional requests for extension will be accepted or approved.
  
- The PWG unanimously approved a motion to recommend extending the expiration date for WP07 (Phase 1) from November 30, 2017, to March 18, 2018, making it consistent with the recommended expiration date for WP08 (Phase 2.)

There were no action items or direction provided during the meeting.
