Project Description:

The Clark County Desert Conservation Program (DCP) will conduct Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) certified law enforcement patrols in the Boulder City Conservation Easement (BCCE) to observe human activities in the BCCE, inform the public of the appropriate uses and limitations on uses of the BCCE, where necessary enforce those rules by written warnings and citations, compile written and GIS data, and further the implementation of the Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP).

Primary Deliverables:

1. Conduct POST certified law enforcement patrol of the BCCE (40 patrol hours/week)
2. Provide approximately weekly written law enforcement patrol observations, warning and citation reports
3. Provide approximately weekly GIS data regarding patrol vehicle locations, rates of patrol vehicle travel, and stationary observation locations and lengths

The Clark County Desert Conservation Program (DCP) will conduct outreach, education and training for the public, including teachers and students, in Clark County, Nevada, to raise awareness of desert ecosystems and the threatened desert tortoise and its habitat, and to further the implementation of the Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP).

Primary Deliverables:

1. Provide for ongoing administration and refinement of the education program
2. Conduct a minimum of 12 school assemblies per year
3. Conduct a minimum of 50 Mojave Max classroom lessons per year
4. Conduct one Mojave Max Emergence Contest per year
5. Participate in a minimum of five community outreach events per year
