

What to Know Before You Go

Instructions for Visitors to the McGee Mountain Wild Burro Gather

When and where to meet: Call our *Wild Burro Gather Info Line* at 775-861-6700, option 2 for an update on the pre-gather tour or previous day's gather results. **Unless otherwise noted on the Info Line recording, plan to meet BLM personnel at 5100 E. Winnemucca Blvd. Winnemucca, NV 89445 at 7:30 a.m.**

Transportation: All visitors must have their own transportation – we cannot take people in government vehicles except in an emergency. The gather sites and temporary holding corrals will move around to several locations and the roads can get very rough in and around the gather/trap area. Vehicles **MUST HAVE** 4-wheel drive with high clearance. Visitors must have spare tires (we suggest multiple spare tires!). Gas and full services are available in Fields, OR, Winnemucca, Paradise junction, and Orovada, NV. *Cell phones are also a good idea if you get stranded, though coverage cannot be guaranteed.*

Amenities: There are motels in Winnemucca if you are coming here from outside the area.

Weather conditions: This is Nevada so plan for warm or cold temperatures. Dress accordingly and bring plenty of water! Don't forget a hat for shade!

What to bring:

- Closed-toed sturdy shoes
- Bland-colored clothing (*no wild colors, please*)
- Sunscreen
- Food and water
- Binoculars
- Camera with zoom lens
- Small beach chair if you don't like to sit on rocks
- Layers of clothes for cold or warm weather

****There will not be a porta-potty at the holding site so plan accordingly.***
