Summary

The dataset was developed to support the National Sage-Grouse Planning Strategy Nevada and northeastern California planning region. This dataset supports the alternatives for the GRSG FEIS 2015

Description

GRSG conservation measures in A Report on National Greater Sage-Grouse Conservation Measures (NTT 2011) were used to form BLM and Forest Service management direction under Alternative B. Management actions by the BLM and Forest Service in concert with other federal, state, and local agencies, tribes, and private landowners play a critical role in the future trends of GRSG populations. To ensure BLM and Forest Service management actions are effective and based on the best available science, the BLM's National Policy Team created the National Technical Team in August 2011. The BLM's objective for chartering this planning strategy was to develop new or revised regulatory mechanisms, through LUPs, to conserve and restore GRSG and its habitat on BLM-administered and National Forest System lands on a range wide basis over the long term. Conservation measures in the report are applied to GRSG PHMAs and to a lesser extent to GHMAs. The alternative includes all mapped PPH and PGH in with no adjustments. PHMAs have the highest conservation value to maintaining or increasing GRSG populations. The complete NTT report can be reviewed online at:
