Regarding – Federal Pipeline Right of Way

Dear Ms. Woods:

The Cold Creek Canyon Homeowners Association has been notified that there is a federal right of way currently being considered for approval that will directly affect the productivity of the wells that are used to supply water to our community. The pipeline is proposed to take water from basin #161 and transfer the water to rural counties in Nevada.

Cold Creek Canyon, and other communities in this area, has existing water rights to access the water in this basin for the use for the community. Pumping high volumes of water from our basin to provide water for other areas is something that we feel will greatly jeopardize our ability to pump the water necessary for our community. This pumping will draw down the aquifer allowing less water to be accessible by the existing wells in the basin.

Cold Creek Canyon Homeowners Association is adamantly apposed to the approval of the right of way for this pipeline.
