Subject Clark, Lincoln and White Pine Counties Groundwater
Development Project Comments

Please accept this Email as my public comments opposing the Clark, Lincoln and White Pine Counties Groundwater Development Project. In my opinion, this is yet another rape of rural Nevadans by the urban majority. Clark County should not be automatically entitled to all of the state's resources simply because it includes the state's largest population center.

Water resources in rural Nevada are also limited. This is the first year that I can remember since the late 1990s that water restrictions have not been imposed locally. Constructing a pipeline and other infrastructure to transport groundwater from rural counties to Las Vegas is a short-term and short-sighted solution. I believe that desalinated seawater transported in from California would offer the greatest longevity and the most effective, most efficient, and least disruptive solution to Clark County's water needs, rather than robbing rural Nevada of crucial water supplies to slake Clark County's apparently insatiable thirst for state resources.
