

Rules and Guidelines

We want to share the public meeting rules and guidelines that will be followed on Saturday along with the Bluff Community Center policies:

Public Meeting Rules and Guidelines

- All meeting participants will have an opportunity to provide written comments.
- Due to time constraints, not everyone will be able to provide spoken public comment. Spoken public comments will be on the basis of a lottery system. Admission to the meeting does not guarantee an opportunity to speak.
- Spoken public comments may be offered for up to two minutes per speaker. Only one person may speak during each time slot. Time may not be transferred, shared, traded, or accumulated.
- Speakers will use respectful language, and will refrain from personal attacks or threats.
- Speakers will be allowed to comment without interruption for two minutes so long as these guidelines are honored.
- Participants accept that the purpose of today's session is to listen to different perspectives and interests, and will not interrupt or interfere with the listening process or other speakers.
- Participants will honor requests from the Secretary, Under Secretary and the meeting moderator.
- All meeting participants implicitly accept the letter and spirit of these guidelines and will participate consistent with the guidelines.

Bluff Community Center Rules and Guidelines

- No eating or drinking within the Center, except for clear liquids;
- No firearms on site or in the Center.
