### UTAH GEOTHERMAL LEASE SALE NOMINATIONS

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Utah State Office is accepting nominations of lands for competitive geothermal leasing for a competitive geothermal lease sale tentatively scheduled for May 19, 2015. Land nominations must be submitted on Department of the Interior (DOI), BLM Form 3203-1, and comply with 43 CFR 3203 (72 FR 24406, May 2, 2007). Please refer to these regulations for nomination requirements regarding maximum acreage, acceptable land descriptions, and nominating parcels as a block. These regulations may be found at <http://ecfr.gpoaccess.gov> under Title 43, Volume 2, Chapter II, Part 3200. A courtesy copy of Form 3203-1 has been enclosed for your convenience.

Nominations are not automatically placed on a sale when received, and the BLM cannot guarantee that the nominated lands will always be included on a particular sale notice. The parcels must be reviewed for availability, as well as environmental and cultural concerns, prior to being placed on a sale. Sale parcels will normally be configured as requested; however, the BLM reserves the right to adjust the parcel size and configuration as needed.

As required by the FY 2014 Fee Schedule for Fixed Fees (43 CFR 3100.12), each nomination must be submitted with a nonrefundable filing fee of \$110.00 per nomination plus \$0.11 per acre of lands nominated. If a land parcel consists of fractional acreage, please round the land acres up to the nearest whole acre.
