

MAINTENANCE FEE--INCREASED TO \$155 IN EFFECT FOR THE 2015 FILING YEAR, WHICH IS DUE ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1, 2014:

For lode claims, mill sites and tunnel sites: annual maintenance fee is \$155 for each claim/site.

For placer claims: the annual maintenance fee is \$155 for each 20 acres of the placer claim or portion thereof.

If the claimant paid the \$140 fee for each claim/site for the 2015 filing year, then the additional \$15 fee must be submitted.

LOCATION FEE HAS ALSO INCREASED TO \$37.

Notice of Location (NOL) recordation fee:

With date of location prior to September 1, 2014, \$194 per claim/site fee is required at the time of recordation with BLM. This fee covers--\$20 nonrefundable processing fee, \$34 location fee, and the \$140 maintenance fee for the assessment year in which the claim/site is located.

With date of location on or after September 1, 2014, \$212 per claim/site fee is required at the time of recordation with BLM. This fee covers--\$20 nonrefundable processing fee, \$37 location fee, and the \$155 maintenance fee for the assessment year in which the claim/site is located.

(For placer claims, the maintenance fee is paid for each 20 acres of the placer claim or portion thereof.)

NOTICE TO CLAIMANTS WITH PLACER MINING CLAIMS:

The maintenance fee rate has increased to \$155 and location fee has increased to \$37. The charts below show the placer notice of location recordation fee and the annual maintenance fee.

The \$155 maintenance fee rate is effective for the 2015 filing year.
