Offering halter and saddle started horses. Halter horses are First Come, First Served for \$125, then Adopt-a-Buddy Horse for \$25 with the adoption of a full fee horse. Saddle started horses are available using silent bid with opening bid of \$250.

NOTE: Officers search vehicles and property as a condition of entering and exiting, to ensure everyone's safety and to look for items that are not allowed into the prison.

Some items such as tobacco and pepper spray, which are not illegal, are considered contraband inside the Prison. Other items not allowed include, but are not limited to: alcohol, explosive items, poisons, weapons, dogs and controlled substances. Each individual 16 yrs of age and older will be asked to provide photo identification, either a driver's license or other State ID card.
