

## **FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT (FONSI)**

ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT (EA) UT- DOI-BLM-UT-W020-2015-0017

Population Control Research Wild Horse Gather for the  
Conger and Frisco Herd Management Areas

This unsigned FONSI and the attached EA UT- DOI-BLM-UT-W020-2015-0017 for the Cedar City and Fillmore field offices are available for public review and comment for 30 days beginning on April 15, 2016.

Based on the analysis of potential environmental impacts in the attached EA and consideration of the significance criteria in 40 CFR 1508.27, I have determined that with required and proposed mitigating measures the Population Control Research Wild Horse Gather for the Conger and Frisco Herd Management Areas would not result in significant impacts on the human environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required.

The decision to approve or deny the Population Control Research Wild Horse Gather for the Conger and Frisco Herd Management Areas, and if appropriate a signed FONSI with rationale, will be released after consideration of public comments and completion of the EA.
