- 1) February 27, 2015 A 10-year old dun stud died due to chronic heart failure. An 11-year old bay mare died due to impact with corral panels at temporary holding. Both were body class 4.

NOTE:

NARRATIVE / COMMENTS

Gather, Removal, and Treatment Summary

The capture objective for the gather is 100 from inside and outside the Sulphur HMA along or near HWY 21. Also 10-15 head from the Great Basin National Park.

Approximately 115 excess wild horses will be placed into the Delta facility.

Daily Gather Activity Summary

Sulphur Hwy 21 Gather

2/25 – 14 Head Gathered (5 mares, 3 studs, 6 yearlings). Horses in Body Class 3-5 with average 4. Shipped to Delta Corrals.

2/26 – 62 Head Gathered (20 mares, 30 studs, 10 yearlings, 2 foals). Horses in Body Class 3-5 with average 4. 60 head shipped to Delta Corrals and 1 foal placed into foster care.

2/27 – 27 Head Gathered (8 mares, 8 studs, 9 yearlings). Horses in Body Class 3-4 with average 4. 2 Deaths: A 10-year old dun stud died due to chronic heart failure. An 11-year old bay mare died due to impact with corral panels at temporary holding. Both were body class 4.

Summary: Two horses gathered on Friday February 27, 2015 were identified by a Utah State Brand Inspector as domestic stray animals. These horses were shipped to Delta, but will be taken into possession by the State of Utah Livestock Inspection Department to try and find the appropriate owner(s). A foal was placed into foster care to provide the best care possible for it's long-term survival. Final gather numbers summary are as follows: Total gathered 103 - 2 domestic horses, 2 deaths, and 1 foal placed into foster care. This places 98 horses (52 studs, 45 mares, 1 foal) at the Delta Utah facility for adoption or sale.
