


Water Erosion Areas (K factor > .40)

- .44 - .49
- .50 - .55
- Areas with a K Factor < .40

NOTE: Classifications are based on the K factor; a rating of susceptibility to sheet and rill erosion based on soil composition, structure, and permeability. A "K" factor higher than .40 is considered high potential for erosion. This map uses generalized soils information. Mapped areas could contain areas of higher or lower erosion potential if more detailed soil surveys were used.
