- **WHO:** All ages are welcome. Volunteers under 18 must be accompanied by an adult. Pre-registration not required.
- **WHAT:** Learn about pioneer history and help clean up litter at a popular public recreation area near the California National Historic Trail in Tooele County.
- **WHEN:** Saturday, Sept. 25, 2010; 10 AM to 2 PM
- **WHERE:** Lone Rock; 45 minutes west of Salt Lake City on Interstate 80, just 3 miles south of Exit 77.
- **HOW:** Be prepared for outdoor weather. Bring work gloves, shovels, rakes, and buckets if possible. Wear shoes that protect your feet. Trash bags and dumpster will be provided. Check in with BLM representatives when you arrive. Bring a lunch; bottled water will be provided free of charge.

Participants will receive complimentary t-shirts and souvenirs.
