

Deep Creek Mountains Wilderness Study Area (WSA) Regulations

L Off-Highway Vehicles (OHV)

- Motor vehicle travel limited to designated routes only within the Wilderness Study Area (WSA).
- Vehicle travel outside WSA boundary limited to existing routes.
- Cross-country vehicle travel strictly prohibited.
- Persons under 18 years old must wear helmets while operating off-highway vehicles.

O Fire Restrictions

- Campfires may be prohibited during times of high fire danger. Call 801-977-4300 for current fire restrictions.
- Do not leave campfires unattended. Put all fires dead out before leaving. Collect only dead and down wood. No tree cutting.
- Discharging any kind of fireworks or other pyrotechnic devices is prohibited at all times on federal public lands.

E Stock Use

- Use of certified weed-free hay or feed is required.

1/4 9 Camping

- Camping on public land is limited to 14 days in any 28 day period.
- Do not leave any personal property unattended for longer than 48 hours.
- No trash dumping on public land. Carry out everything you carry in.
