

Solid leasables – Within the Vernal Field Office, there are federal gilsonite and phosphate leases as well as pending prospecting permit applications for gilsonite and phosphate. Our office has title plats showing the location of leases and pending and authorized prospecting permit applications, as well as, nominations of oil shale [RD&D tracts](#). The BLM Utah State Office in Salt Lake City (324 South State Street, Suite 301; P.O. Box 45155, Salt Lake City, UT 84145-0155) is the office responsible for receiving and processing applications for leasing and prospecting for solid leasables in Utah, pursuant to the [43 CFR 3500 regulations](#). The Utah State Office also approves all plans for mining and exploring for solid leasables (for more information about how to file for permits and leases, contact [Bill Buge@blm.gov](mailto:Bill_Buge@blm.gov) ; and for more information about filing exploration-reclamation or mining-reclamation plans, contact [Stan Perkes@blm.gov](mailto:Stan_Perkes@blm.gov)). Field Offices usually write the environmental documentation related to solid leasable mineral actions.
