

Salables [mineral materials] – Each Field Office is responsible for accepting and processing applications for sales and permits for sand, gravel, stone and other mineral materials on public lands they administer (pursuant to the [43 CFR 3600 regulations](#)). See the How to Obtain Sand Gravel and Other Mineral Materials pamphlet (www.blm.gov/nhp/300/wo320/sndgrvl.html). The Vernal Field Office offers over-the-counter sales of stone for personal [noncommercial] use only from two common use areas; the Buck Canyon area about 50 miles south of Vernal, Utah and the West Wrinkles about 33 miles southwest of Roosevelt, Utah. We also offer sales of sand and gravel from two community pits; the Green River pit about 9.5 miles south of Vernal and the Wild Mountain pit about 25 miles northeast of Vernal. Contact us for further information about our over-the-counter sales. Our office administers several contract sales for sand, sand and gravel, and stone as well as free use permits issued to local Counties, Cities and other governmental agencies. The Vernal Field Office does require a mine and reclamation plan for all contract sales and free use permits, and will, on a case-by-case basis, recover costs for processing all exclusive contract sale applications. The location of sales and permits appear on BLM title plats.
