### **Vernal Field Office Issues Supplement to Draft Resource Management Plan**

Vernal, Utah — The Bureau of Land Management Vernal Field Office announces the availability of the Supplement to the Draft Vernal Resource Management Plan/Environmental Impact Statement (DRMP/EIS) released January 2005. The Supplement to the Vernal DRMP/EIS identifies non-Wilderness Study Area (WSA) lands the BLM has found to possess wilderness characteristics and analyzes a fifth alternative (Alternative E). This alternative emphasizes managing those lands to preserve and protect their wilderness characteristics. In order to have the full context for this Supplement, refer to the Vernal Field Office DRMP/DEIS, which includes a description of the alternatives, environment, and anticipated impacts. A limited number of hard copies of the DRMP/DEIS are available on a first-come/first-served basis at the Vernal Field Office.

**Comments on the Supplement** will be accepted during a 90-day public comment period beginning Oct. 5, and ending Jan. 3, 2008.
