The Electronics Technician understands the design, capabilities, and limits of electronic equipment and systems. The Electronics Technician consistently evaluates and improves existing electronic systems. And, on a daily basis, the BLM Electronics Technician communicates with a diverse group of employees who depend not only upon the technician's expertise but also his / her ability to understand the average employee's technical needs.

Coursework in Electronics must include a minimum of 6 semester hours.

Education must include a minimum of 2 years of college or technical school.
