Notes:

- (1) The performance goal for FY 2007 was to have 80% of the BLM's organizational units rated in good safety, health, and environmental condition.
- (2) The above data includes audits performed from October 1993 through June 2007 and responses from the field on the findings from those audits through July 2007.
- (3) FY 2007 is the third fiscal year in which an organizational unit must have all its high priority CASHE findings completed to be rated in good condition. This standard has been phased in since FY 2000 when an organizational unit could have up to five high priority findings and still be rated in good condition. In each fiscal year since FY 2000, the good condition standard has been reduced by one high priority finding until it reached zero in FY 2005.
