Archeology Collections:

University of Alaska museum provided a list of accession numbers that they believe are collections for which BLM is responsible. It contains none of the early collections, for which BLM may be responsible, and does not appear to contain anything later than 1999. No one in BLM has reviewed this list to determine if these are, in fact, BLM collections. Based on the accession information provided, 215 sites were identified by the museum as being exclusive to BLM, 38 of these sites have been catalogued and represent a total of 3,880 items.
