

## FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

### **Finding of No Significant Impact:**

I have reviewed the Environmental Assessment (EA), AZ-410-2008-0019, for the Dry Lake Wind Project, including the explanation and resolution of any potentially significant environmental impacts. I have determined that the Proposed Action with the mitigation measures proposed in the EA will not have any significant impacts on the human environment and that an Environmental Impact Statement is not required. I have determined that the Proposed Action is in conformance with the Phoenix Resource Management Plan and Final Environmental Impact Statement (RMP/FEIS) approved in a Record of Decision dated 1988.


### **Below are the substantive reasons for finding no significant impact:**

- The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service concurred that the Proposed Action would have no effect or would not likely adversely affect federally listed endangered or threatened species or the designated critical habitat of listed species.
- The State Historic Preservation Office concurred with the determinations of eligibility for properties included on the National Register of Historic Places for the Project and supported the proposed plan to avoid Register-eligible sites through Project design.
- The Proposed Action would avoid or have only minor impacts on Critical Elements of the Human Environment.
- Mitigation would avoid or minimize impacts on wildlife populations associated with the desert scrub/grassland and pinyon/juniper woodland habitats found within the Colorado Plateau Ecoregion.
