Vision Statement

Eric and Kirk will take the proposed changes and changes discussed today and craft a new proposed statement. This will be circulated by email for group review.

National Permit Stipulations

Many folks showed interest in these. Kristen was concerned that no one had spoken directly with BLM staff about this and it exceeded her powers to put this in place. Kirk stated that the subject was discussed in the Data Steward (internal BLM) call of October, so BLM Data Stewards should have some knowledge of this. As well, the Preservation Board is aware of these stipulations and the plan for making them national eventually.

Jeff Overturf echoed the value of national stipulations. USFS will be implementing the requirements that go to the tabular data level.

Monica and Dan stated that the overall goal in BLM is centralized data management. This provoked concern from SHPOs re: a single central database. The BLM Geospatial Services Plan for 2008 is to have a single service point for all geospatial services.

Nancy Schamu clarified that the overall goal from Washington D.C. is *not* to have a centralized single database of cultural resources. Rather, it is oriented toward interoperability between state inventories.

Dan clarified the central data management goals and applauded the “get involved to determine our own fate” approach advocated by Monica.

State of the States 10 Year Survey – BLM Internal

Kirk reported that the internal BLM survey – circulated to partners for reference in the meeting packet – has been returned by most states. The surveys will be compiled and the results returned to the group.

State of the States 10 Year Survey – SHPO Internal

Eric and Kirk will be discussing a 10 year survey format for distribution to the SHPOs to get the SHPO assessment of the “state of their state”. This will probably be a much

shorter version of the survey created for internal BLM, with some of the data status questions collected two years ago as part of the CRDSP summary report.

Spring Meeting Location

The annual meeting will be held in Carson City, Nevada in either late April or mid-May of 2008. Karyn deDuFour and Eric Ingbar will organize the local arrangements with Kirk's guidance and direction.
