Welcome to the Bureau of Land Management's CD for the **Draft Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement for Vegetation Treatments Using Aminopyralid, Fluroxypyr, and Rimsulfuron on Bureau of Land Management Lands in 17 Western States**. The CD contains the Draft Programmatic EIS, Final Biological Assessment, and reports that describe the effects of vegetation treatments using three herbicides on human health, the ecological risks associated with the use of the three herbicides, and the effects of the herbicides on Alaska Native and American Indian resource uses. The reports, which were used to prepare the Draft Programmatic EIS, provide more detailed information than could be included in the Draft Programmatic EIS.

The CD is an interactive version of the Draft Programmatic EIS and the associated reports. For a quick overview, read the Abstract and Executive Summary in the Draft Programmatic EIS.

Viewing the Draft Programmatic EIS on CD, Paper, or the Web Site

Whether you read the Draft Programmatic EIS on CD, the BLM website, or as a hard copy, you will find that all formats contain the same information. However, the presentation on the interactive sites may differ slightly from what you see on the hard copy version.

Viewing the CD
