1975, 77, 79, 81,83 Interpolated population based on recruitment of 20% and removals.

1984-2000 Population figures are taken from the End of Year statistics calculated to September 30 of that year.

2000 Reporting for current population numbers changed in FY 2000. Populations are reported as of 3/1/ so they include recruitment but not the foal crop for the current populations. AML is also displayed as the upper limit. Removals and Adoptions are reported at the end of the FY.

1971 Estimated populations at time of passage of the Act.

1976 FLPMA authorizes helicopter gathers. Initiated the Adopt-A\_Horse or Burro Program.

1978 Public Rangelands Improvement Actn (PRIA) allows titling of adopted animals.

1980-81 No standard fee. Transportation and veterarian fees paid by adopter.

1982 Burford policy; moratorium on the destruction of excess, unadopted horses.

1983 Adoption fees set at \$125 plus transportation.

1985 Congress directed BLM to triple removals. Standard adoption fee set at \$125.

1987-88 Fee waiver adoptions. Interior Appropriation Rider stating no funds can be expended on the destruction of healthy, unadoptable horses.

1989-90 Removals impacted by appeals by humane groups to IBLA.

1994 Desert Protection Act passed.

1998-99 BLM limited removals and concentrated on adoptions to move animals out of holding facilities.

2001 First year of the 4 year WH&B Initiative.
