


## **WHICH MODULE(S) SHOULD I USE?**

Data Analysis Modules.zip contains three files:



Each module is applicable to a plant region as defined in the 2014 National Wetlands Plant List, <http://plants.usda.gov/core/wetlandSearch>

The following map depicts each of the three regions in the Western US: ARID, WESTERN MOUNTAINS/VALLEYS and COAST, and GREAT PLAINS.



**Data Entry Modules for Tablet.zip** contains three files applicable to the same regions as the Data Analysis Modules.zip (ARID, GP, and WVM). As with the Data Analysis Module, the user selects that module specific to his/her region. The tablet version is designed specifically for entering data using a device that supports "touch screen" input. Most of the data entry cells will expand in size upon selection. Many more drop-down lists are provided to minimize typing, allowing the user to select items in the list. Tablets using this module preferably operate in a Windows environment using MS EXCEL. Field data are transferred to the Data Analysis Module for analysis.

**Data Entry Modules for Field PDAs** contains two files specifically designed for use with field devices that support Windows Mobile with EXCEL Mobile or other device that does not support the full version of Windows and MS EXCEL. The **Data Entry Module** provides for recording field data that is later transferred to the Data Analysis Module for analysis. The **Data Entry Module Grazing Use** is used specifically for entering short-term monitoring data, stubble height, bank alteration, bank stability, and woody use.
