


<i>(Describe exact rationale for above change to include reference material, i.e., EA, EIS, IM, etc.)</i>				
<p>This maintenance action clarifies and documents a previously approved decision in the 1985 Buffalo RMP, its subsequent amendment, and analysis (43 CFR 1610.4-4). This maintenance action does not change or prevent change of the management or use of public lands as approved in the 1985 Buffalo RMP and subsequent planning documents. The Federal Land Policy and Management Act (FLPMA), 1976, Sections 201, 202, 203, and 310 set the requirements for the BLM to inventory, identify, plan for the use, acquire, and occasionally the disposal of some public lands according to strict criteria. BLM earlier determined the 9 parcels, above, met the criteria for direct sale or were subject to a trespass, (Section 203(1), 1985 RMP, and 43 CFR 2710, et. seq.), as they are small, irregularly shaped, completely surrounded by lands in one ownership with no surface public access, difficult and uneconomic to manage, are unsuitable for management by another federal department or agency, and/or resolve a trespass. BLM approved Map 7A of the 1985 Buffalo FEIS, via the 1985 Buffalo RMP ROD, pp. 13 and 14 in 1985, the above amendment, analysis; and see generally, Buffalo Resource Area Management Framework Plan, 1978. Subsequent Interior Department (DOI) and BLM guidance sought clarification of land disposal maps and text with the legal descriptions for the parcels identified for consideration for disposal.</p>
