

Pinedale Anticline Transportation Task Group Meeting

Meeting minutes for 01/11/05
Board Room Sublette County Library, Pinedale, Wyoming

- Attendees, see attached form. No general public's attended the meeting.
- Minutes from the 12/7/04 meeting were reviewed by the Task Group and approved with two minor changes.
- An over view of the PAWG meeting held on 1/5/05 was given to the Task Group.
- Ron Brown brought up concerns of the heavy truck traffic in town (condensate spill)
- The problem of increasing produced water volumes was brought up. Richard Kail was going to contact Richard Rieman BLM to obtain estimates on future volumes of both condensate and produced water to estimate trucking needs.
- Questar is currently piping their produced water to Anticline Disposal pit south of the New Fork River.
- Economics is the driving force behind whether produced water and condensate is trucked vs. a pipeline system.
- BLM policy, that no disposal pits are placed on public land if lease lines are crossed due to Haz-Mat issues.
- Questar's estimated peak production of produced water is 6500 barrels per day.
- Meeting location was discussed and consensus was to stay in the same place (Lovatt room Sublette County Library).
- Draft plan to PAWG was discussed and consensus was reach to include the following:
 - Task Group recommending 7 monitoring site (traffic counts).
 - Paradise Road and South Mesa Road
 - Tyler Street
 - Boulder South and Middle Crest Road
 - Highway 351 and North Jonah Road
 - Southern Anticline Crest Road and North Jonah Road
 - East Green River Road and Flying Heart Road
 - Southern Anticline Crest Road and Highway 191
- Task Group recommending the following as mitigation measures:
- To help traffic problem on Tyler Street; By-pass south of Pinedale from Highway 191 to Sublette County road 23-123 and/or from the Industrial Site south to 23-123.
- Bridge crossing the New Fork to connect the Boulder South Road (23-106) with the Paradise Road (23-136).
- Turn lane off Highway 191 onto Paradise Road (23-136).
- Turn lane off Highway 351 onto Paradise Road (23-136).

- Connector road between the Antelope area and Luman Road on the south end of the Pinedale anticline.
 - Speed Limits be posted:
 - BLM to provide speed limits and signs
 - Operators to Install signs
 - Sublette County to patrol and enforce
 - Highway 351 be looked at for safety (reduced speed limit at critical points)
 - Produced water and condensate pipelines be built and used by all operators to reduce truck traffic.
 - The following two items are for Emergency Management System:
 - Common Road naming system
 - Master map be produced showing roads, pads and pipelines. BLM to be responsible for the map and keeping Sublette County informed. Operators to provide timely updates to BLM.
- Next meeting 01/25/05 Sublette County Library at 1 PM.
