Minutes April 6 , 2006

Minutes of February 27, 2006 were reviewed and approved .

Sam Trautman showed Lander Trail Monitoring video for task group's comments .

Group comments were that video was done well and liked what they saw ..Going out again end of May or early June to revisit 10 points that are at ¼ mile intervals on Lander Trail and take 360 degree video at each point to see if any changes in view shed .

Want to do for year 2006.

1. Visual record of new wells year to year .
2. Link wells to key observation points .
3. Provide GPS data that shows wells in Lander Trail view shed .
4. Complete description at what you are seeing when you are comparing views .

Professional video costs are \$12,000 approximately .

Clint met with PAWG group with monitoring plan and they said that the plan needs to be prioritized by cost.

1. Items in plan that are at no costs .
2. Items in plan at low costs .
3. Items in plan at high costs and labor .

Suggested by group to have PAWG strongly recommend BLM replace Kierson's position .

Also, that Sam Drucker take over the duties that Kierson did in assisting the group with various topics .  
It was suggested that BLM give Sam and Dave more time to study soil study report that was made for the Anticline area .

Group recommended professional video for this year for educational purposes .

Group broke down monitoring plan for 2007 budget .

No costs which Clint will prioritize :

- 1 Replace Kierson

2. Increase number of volunteers
3. Include BLM site visits with dataset
4. Blm should budget time to view 2005 data prior to 2006 field season
5. Target advertising for potential graduate research
6. BLM continue public outreach
7. Create PowerPoint teacher kits for fourth grades
8. Antiquities Act celebration and open archeology presentations at museums
9. Work up manner of agreement with BLM,SHPO and operators on what is not covered by Wyoming protocol
10. Artifact collection signs at major entrances to Mesa
11. Spring newspaper articles on artifact collecting
12. Educate County Deputies and Game and Fish to look out for collectors
13. Operators to educate employees on collection rules

Low costs :

1. Wardell install surveillance cameras
2. BLM should budget time to integrate soil data with known cultural sites database
3. Make educational booklet about human history of Anticline area

High priority and costs

1. Wardell Buffalo Site finish stabilization
2. Additional Ranger for Anticline area
3. Lander Trail video for 2007
4. Budget time and expertise to synthesis data for known cultural sites

Dennis suggested Archeological site events be open to public 2 or 3 times a year .

Clint suggested leave a future meeting open .
