PAWG status : Has all 9 members ,7 members appointed in late October 2006 , met once on
November 6,2006 to organize and meet each other Next PAWG meeting January 26-
27 , 2007 .

Project status : 1..\$ 6,000.00 to finish stabilizing Wardell Buffalo Site this spring .
2. \$ 13,000.00 for National Historical Landmarks status from National Parks Service .
3. \$ 40,000.00 from Ultra for Buffalo bone analysis by University Wyoming. .
4. Site stewardship program with State of Wyoming starts June 2007
5. No new news on additional BLM ranger
6. Camera at Wardell site put on hold .
7. Private land between Wardell site and main road unless there is a easement with
land owner there can not be access to site .
8. Lander Trail visual monitoring being done by volunteers but video monitoring
funds need to be found to happen .
9. BLM does not feel video of Trail is monitoring but more educational .
10. Pinedale is looking 2007 as centennial for Lander Trail suggested going to groups to
help with celebration such as OCTA , Historical Society ,etc..
11. Shell and Ultra to go to 16 wells approximately on mega pad .
12. BLM should budget time for Intergraded Soils Data with cultural sites data base .
Dennis Foley to pursue Questar on their soil samples which a lot has been done but
results may be awhile .
13. Develop educational folder no funding .
14. Dave Crouly replaced Kierson Crume .
15. 4 to 5 wildlife signs are up but have room for more information ,plus a couple are ill
placed and need moved to safer locations instead of making area on road a safety
hazard .
16. Suggest we have consultants monitor sites and turn in results to BLM .
17. Visual monitoring Lander Trail that was done hard to find on SHPO website.

18. BLM public outreach program Dave Vicek gave talk on Rendezvous Point at senior center on 12-13-06, this is on going.
19. Nine (9) educational signs still in works.
20. Create power point PAPA educational teacher kits. Sam Drucker has three (3) presentation done waiting for fourth grade teacher to step-up.
21. Open archeology demonstrations in 2006 to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the Antiquities Act, done.
22. Data analysis to have a potential research graduate do this Dave Vicek will promote this program.
23. Artifact collecting signs ordered but have not shown up Dave Vicek to find out where they are and get them up.
24. Newspaper articles about artifact collecting laws might do in Spring 2007.
25. Educate Fish and Game and County Deputies to report artifact collecting violations in to BLM. This is in process.
26. Operators educate employees on artifact collecting laws is a on going thing and could be done at their safety meetings. Could also reward employees for a legitimate find
27. Question do we as a group need to address Paleontology?
28. EIS is coming out shortly.
29. Where does SHPO stand when a Historical Site (such as the Lander Trail) on State land is threaten by drilling or other threat to view shed? SHPO has no known agreement with State on view sheds. State land at present time is same as private lands.
