

PINEDALE ANTICLINE TRANSPORTATION TASK GROUP MEETING

Meeting Minutes for 01-17-2007

Board Room Sublette County Library, Pinedale, Wyoming

Attendees – Charles Price, Bill Wadsworth, Jimmy Druce, Mike Harper, Tom Curry, Therese Hartman, Geoff Sell, Richard Kail

- Therese Hartman was unanimously accepted to become a member of the Task Group
- A letter authored by Charles C. Price was reviewed and agreed upon by committee to be sent to Dennis Stenger of the Pinedale B.L.M office concerning the placement of three wildlife kiosks.
- Discussions were held concerning the proposed by-pass route around Pinedale which includes access to the north end of the Mesa. Key issues discussed were:
 - Industrial Park to Mesa Road portion of route is in original E.I.S
 - The mayor will take the lead in contacting private land owners
 - Consensus is that the town of Pinedale is in favor of by pass route
- Discussions were held concerning the status of the radar system located south of Gobblers Knob on the North Mesa road. The system has been counting vehicles for the past couple of weeks but will have to be downloaded manually. Problems with the transmission of this DATA to a remote computer have been identified as a software problem. Software has been sent back to the manufacturer to be fixed.
- Gates on the Mesa are going to be locked as of 01/17/07. Keys can be checked out at the BLM office on an as needed basis.
- As a representative group the Transportation Task Group will support the use of County & WYDOT matched monies for a traffic and transportation plan as long as clear deliverables are outlined in a manner that a useful product will be attained. Representatives from the State will be conducting a meeting concerning this issue on January 23rd. Charles Price and Geoff Sell indicated that they will attend this meeting.
- The Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement was discussed briefly
 - Public comment is open until March 15th, 2007
 - Bill Wadsworth read several of the main issues within the S.E.I.S
 - The Record of Decision is expected to be signed in mid 2007
